Saturday and Sunday will be open for families of two children, and Monday and Tuesday will be sign-ups for single child families. I encourage you to visit OptionC as soon as possible to view current grades of your child/ren in subjects of non-homeroom teachers. If you wish to conference with any teacher beside the homeroom teacher, please schedule a conference with that teacher on Wednesday, November 1<sup>st</sup>.
